

Links for Life

Objective Social Action:

This activity demonstrates to students that we are all connected. One person's choice affects another person's life, and if we pledge to make better choices we can save lives.

Materials Needed

- Red and green paper cut into strips
 - Stapler
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How the Activity Works

- Set up a table in a central area.
- Hand out strips of green and red paper and ask students to write their names on a strip, pledging to make a safe choice over the holiday season (or during road safety week in the school/ city/ province/ world...).
- Collect the strips and form them into a "Chain for Life" to display at school or in the community.
- Another adjacent table could be set up for students to write names of friends or relatives who were victims of road collisions to display as a part of an Interfaith Memorial Service.

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
